The Victorian Government has announced new directions to prevent the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). As a result, in line with the directions issued from Victoria's Chief Health Officer, all Victorian schools will move to a period of remote learning from Friday May 28 to Thursday June 3 inclusive.

Please be aware that Friday May 28 will be a Staff Professional Practice Day and a Student Home Study Day

Classes will resume on Monday 31 reverting to the previous Remote Learning arrangements. As per the previous arrangements, students are required to attend all scheduled classes on time in full college winter uniform (no PE uniform) and have their camera on. Your teachers will need to physically see you to mark the roll accurately. Please be aware that morning Homeroom will not run during the remote learning period, and there will not be extended pastoral care on Thursday June 3.

Students will be permitted to attend the college for on-site supervision in cases where parents are essential workers and cannot be supervised, are vulnerable or have internet issues. This information has been sent to families via SkoolBag.
