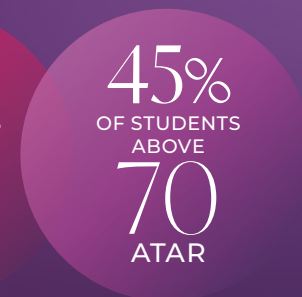
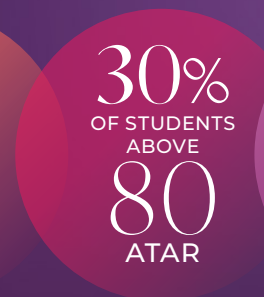
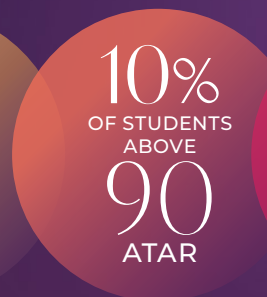
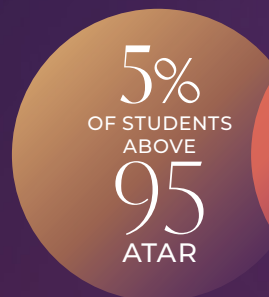
I am proud of these determined young people and congratulate them on all they have achieved for themselves, their families, and the college.
